REMEMBRANCE DAY

Newtown State School will commemorate Remembrance Day with a **special assembly this Friday at 11:00am** on the 'Green'. Remembrance Day is a memorial day that has been observed since the end of the First World War to remember the members of armed forces who paid the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty. Remembrance Day is observed on 11 November to recall the end of hostilities of World War I on that date in 1918. Hostilities formally ended "at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month". Students will assemble at 10:45am. *All welcome.*

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

The Positive Behaviour for Learning focus lesson for this week is **knowing right from wrong**. When we manage behaviour, we ask students to reflect on what has happened, which school value or expectation they were not considering and what choice they are going to make next time they are in a similar situation. Most students are able to articulate this well; knowing right from wrong and are encouraged to practice different strategies and follow the expectations. People who know right from wrong also try to make things right by making an apology, an important part of taking responsibility for one's behaviour.

The **Bedazzled Number 1** awarded on assembly this week went to 3BA for consistently demonstrating being ready to line up after a break.

BEFORE SCHOOL PROCEDURES

Students arriving before 8:30am are to sit on the 'Green'. There is to be no play. This is applicable even when parents/carers are present. Students may proceed to their designated year level play area once the bell has gone and staff supervision has commenced.

SWIMMING LESSONS

All younger siblings attending the pool during school swimming **MUST** be constantly supervised by parents/caregivers. For obvious safety reasons, staff must maintain their attention on students and are not in a position to supervise the younger children.
